## **Germantown Soccer Club COVID-19 Protocols**

6/24/2020

If a player or coach receives a confirmed positive test of COVID-19, the following protocols must be observed:

1. Notify the club immediately
  - a. Germantown Soccer Club COVID-19 contact: Jason Borchard, [jhborchard@hotmail.com](mailto:jhborchard@hotmail.com), (989) 751-3573
2. The name of the affected person will remain confidential, but the team, as well as any opponents played within the last seven (7) days of positive test will be notified
3. The affected player or coach (as well as all family members and those sharing the same house) will not be permitted to return to his/her team for 14 days after a positive test date
4. Germantown Soccer Club will follow WOHD (Washington Ozaukee Health Department) for further action to be taken

If a player or coach experiences known COVID-19 exposure, the following protocols must be observed:

1. Notify the club contact immediately
2. Germantown Soccer Club will notify the persons team of the positive exposure
3. The player or coach (as well as all family members and those sharing the same house) will need to do one of the following prior to rejoining their team:
  - a. Home quarantine for 14 days from exposure
  - b. Proof of a negative test or written confirmation of COVID-19 clearance from your physician

If a player or coach is sent home feeling sick or with a fever, the following protocols must be observed:

1. Notify the club contact immediately
2. Germantown Soccer Club will recommend player or coach is tested immediately
  - a. If test comes back negative and the player or coach is no longer exhibiting symptoms, they may return to team activities immediately
  - b. If the player or coach receives a positive test or chooses not to be tested, they must quarantine themselves for 14 days prior to returning to team activities

Germantown Soccer Club maintains detailed tracking sheets for all team activities so we will easily be able to notify anyone who would have been in contact with the affected person. The only details that will be shared is the approximate date of contact.

Germantown Soccer Club will continue to monitor trends and adjust operations as needed moving forward. This includes, but not limited to, the cancellation of all team training and activities if advised by the WOHD.
